Collaborative Creative Writing Competition
All key stages GERMAN**



Due to the successes of our creative writing competitions in the past, UEA Think German Network would like to invite German language students from all key stages to design and promote their own stall as part of a collaborative virtual Christmas market.

As most Christmas markets in Germany, Austria and Switzerland this year have been cancelled, we have decided to commission our own virtual Christmas fair with individual stalls designed by you and launched on the UEA Think German website. The main idea is that you work collaboratively and creatively with peers in your year group or across year groups to create a virtual Christmas stall. The requirements are that you first design a stall using materials / media of your choice and submit this with a promotional audio clip about your project that should not last longer than 2 minutes.

Ever thought of selling baubles, beeswax candles, mulled wine or *Lebkuchen*? Whether you produce a collage, a painting or drawing of the stall or even build your own proper miniature *Weihnachtsbude*, there is no limit to what shape and form you would like your stall to be. The promotional audio-clip should give further details about what is on offer at your stall and capture the attention of “passers-by”. As an alternative, you could, of course, combine the visual and audio and submit a short video clip of your virtual stall. Just remember that we will need permission from you to publish your finished piece on the website.

A small **jury of German native speaker students** here at UEA will select the best three entries, who will receive prizes from the German Embassy. All participants will receive certificates.
